EXISTING LIGHTING

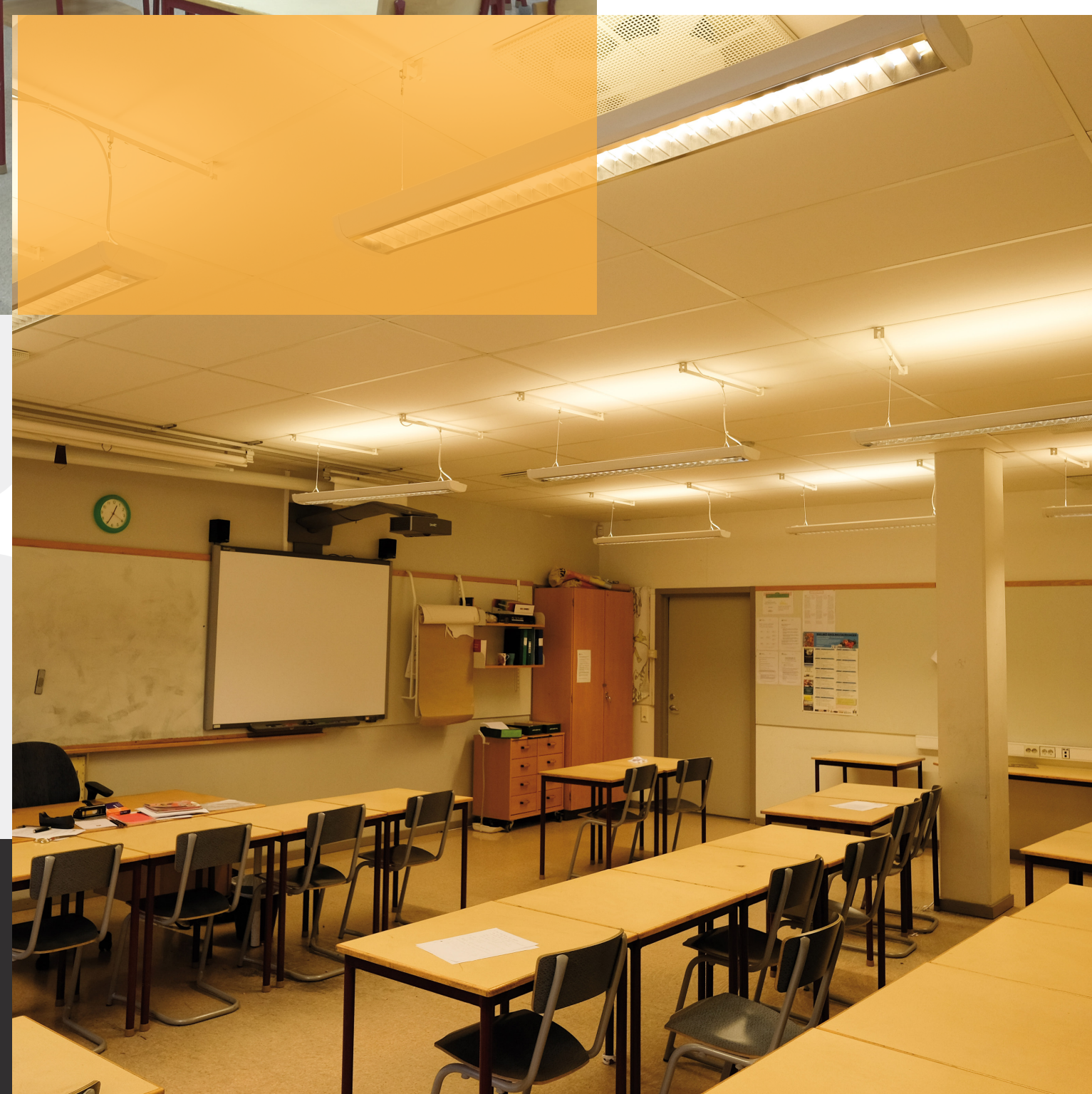
See photo, the T8 fluorescent lamps are 2700K.

THE SOLUTION

A lighting system with 40W LED panels and slow automatic variation of intensity and colour temperatures between 2,700K to 6,500K.
